Declaration on EC Directive 2011/65 / EU on the restriction of use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment (RoHS)

On June 8th, 2011 with the entry into force of the new version of the "Law on the marketing, return and environmentally sound disposal of electrical and electronic equipment", the requirements of the EC Directives 2011/65 / EU (RoHS) were transposed into German law.

The central concern of the law is the reduction of pollutants in electronics as well as the prevention and reduction of electronic waste through reuse. Pollutant limits have been in place since July 1st, 2006 and include lead, mercury, cadmium, polybrominated biphenyls (PBB), polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) and chromium-VI compounds. The expanded ROHS directive has been in force since July 22, 2019, with new substance use bans.

Durbal Metallwarenfabrik GmbH develops, produces and sells products that aren't directly affected by the law. Nevertheless our products can be part of and used in applications that apply to the law mentioned above.

According to our certifications, ISO 9001: 2015 and ISO 14001: 2015, we are in constant dialogue with our suppliers to make sure that all delivered products are RoHS compliant.
